K&N® Cabin Air Filters replace your vehicle's stock cabin filter with a reusable design that cleans and freshens incoming air. They are electrostatically charged to grab and hold dust particles. K&N® cabin air filters help control odors while they help capture most mold, mildew, fungus, spores, bacteria and germs. When they get dirty they can be cleaned and reused and best of all, they come with a 10 year/Million mile limited warranty.

When applicable, refer to owner's manual for manufacturers installation/removal instructions. The following are helpful steps when replacing/servicing cabin air filter with K&N® cabin air filter.

1. Remove the two screws below the glove box. Fig. 1
2. Open the glove box and remove the top three screws. Fig. 2
3. Remove the glove box to gain access to the cabin filter door. Fig. 3 and 4
4. Remove the dirty filter and clean any debris that might be present inside the housing. Fig. 5
5. Install one of the two K&N® cabin filters. Push the first filter in and to the right of the housing then install the second filter. Fig. 6 and 7
6. Install the K&N® door by hooking the feature shown in Fig. 8 to the right side of the housing then lock the left side. Fig. 9
7. Reverse steps 1-3 to complete the cabin filter installation. Clean an area and apply the K&N® Stop Decal.
The decal will help notify others that this is a reusable cabin filter.
